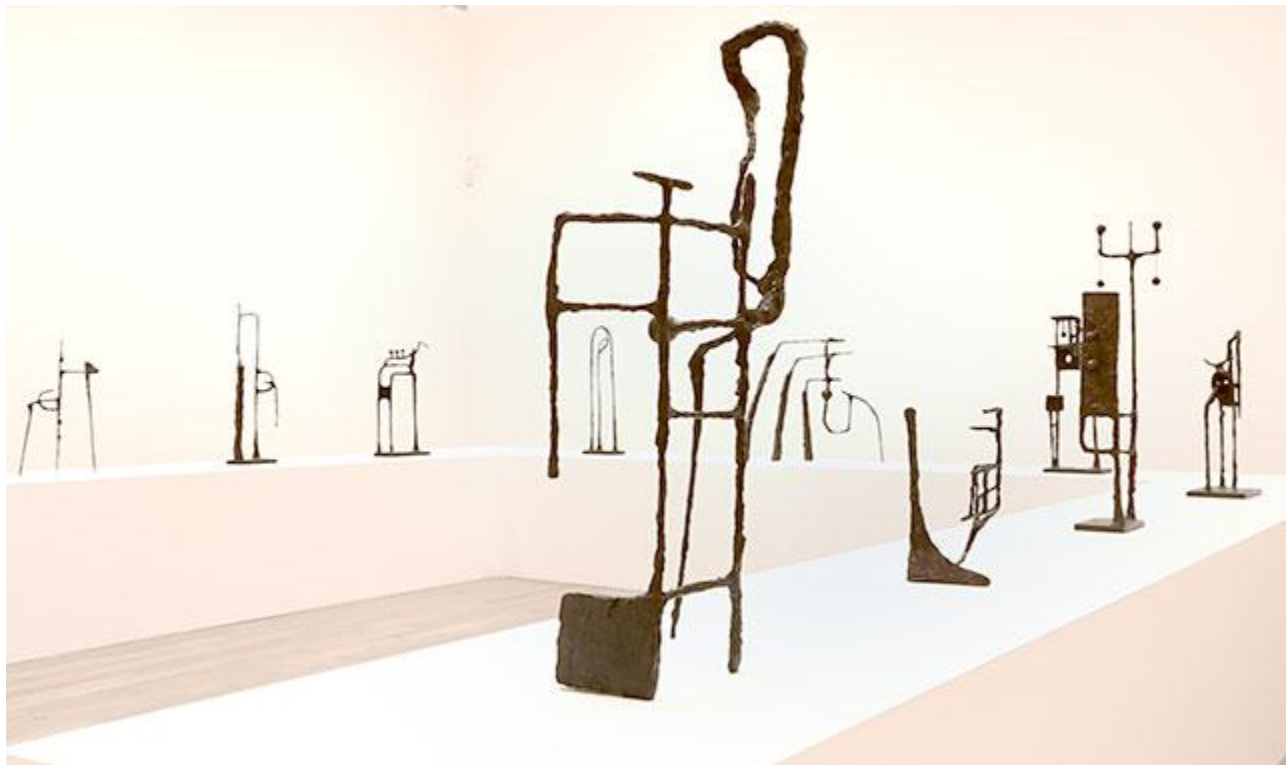

For Shanghai-based sculptor, Wang Xieda, the evolution of Chinese calligraphy actuates inspiration for his three-dimensional models.
